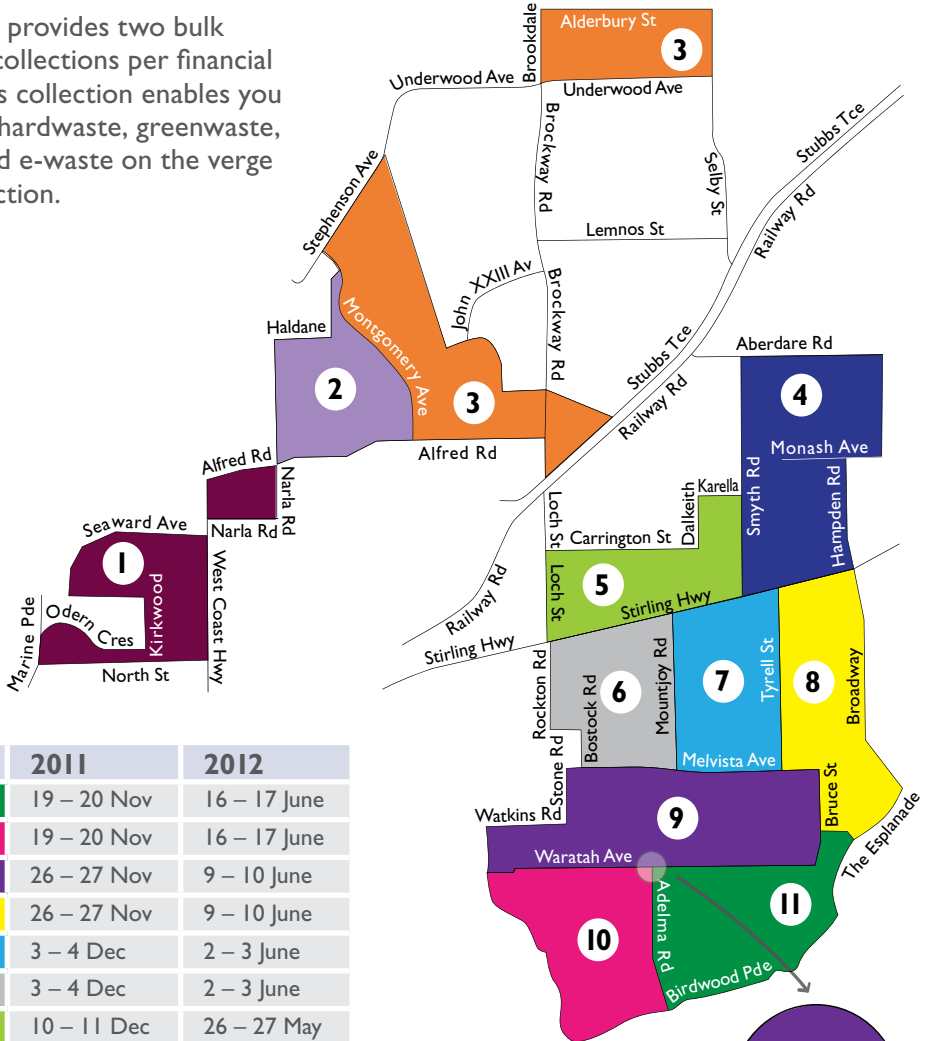


# BULK COLLECTION CALENDAR

The City provides two bulk rubbish collections per financial year. This collection enables you to place hardwaste, greenwaste, metal and e-waste on the verge for collection.

Please place your bulk waste into separate piles on your verge.

## YES

- ✓ Household furniture
- ✓ White goods and metal products including degassed fridges, stoves and washing machines (doors removed)
- ✓ E-waste such as televisions and computers
- ✓ Prunings less than 1.5m in length and 10cm in diameter with cut ends toward the street
- ✓ Small loose greenwaste placed in the City's reusable greenwaste bags
- ✓ Household electronic items
- ✓ Unwanted household items

## NO

- ✗ Tree trunks, lawn sods and soil
- ✗ Food waste
- ✗ Building materials including rubble, bricks, paving, tiles, concrete, gravel, glass, hardiflex and supersix fencing
- ✗ Asbestos cement products
- ✗ Motor parts including tyres
- ✗ Gas cylinders
- ✗ Hazardous liquids including paints, oils and chemicals
- ✗ Glass or mirrors
- ✗ Solar panels
- ✗ Broken television screens
- ✗ Medical waste

# ABOUT YOUR BULK COLLECTION

---

**Place your materials out for collection as specified to ensure public safety and prevention of property damage.**

- Bulk rubbish should be placed on verges no more than seven days prior to your collection.
- Ensure your bulk collection materials are less than six cubic metres or two trailer loads of material.
- Place your bulk rubbish on the verge before 6am on the Monday of your collection week.
- Check that pedestrians, cyclists and motorists still have clear visibility. Keep rubbish one metre clear of sprinklers, water meters, power poles and street signs to avoid any damage during the collection process.
- Keep rubbish clear of the footpath.
- Household items, greenwaste, metals and electronic waste (e-waste) are to be placed in separate piles.

## **DID YOU KNOW?**

*Placing waste on verges following the bulk collection is a littering offence.*
