Recently the City of Nedlands became a signatory of the UN Sustainable **Development Goals.**

The Sustainable Development Goals or SDG's build on the principle of "leaving no one behind" and provide a holistic approach to sustainable development. By becoming a signatory, the City is committed to implementing the goals' strategic intent, to provide sustainable service delivery in the local community.

A great example of this is the recent introduction of FOGO in Nedlands. With the first waste pickup service scheduled for 7 November, don't forget to check which bins to leave out on your waste calendar or via the City's website.

Furthermore, if you would like to make a submission on the City's 'Draft Trees on Private Land - Scheme Amendment 12' or 'Draft Local Planning Policy', please visit the City's online engagement platform, Your Voice, via the City's website. Submissions close on 11 December.

Some positive news from the City of Nedlands Administration. The City's new digital Customer Relationship System, OneCouncil, is proving to be extremely successful. Since going live on 1 July, almost 9,000 requests have been received, with 95% of these resolved within 7 working days.

Lastly, as part of the Local Government Reforms, the Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries have proposed a reduction in the size of our Council which could reduce the number of Councillors from 12 to 8 (excluding the Mayor). The City encourages all community members to participate in this process by having their say on the reform via the City's engagement platform, YourVoice.

Animal registration reminder

City Rangers would like to remind dog and cat owners that registration renewals were due on Monday 31 October 2022. If you haven't already, please ensure that when registering your animal, you include their microchip number and contact details. This ensures that in the event your animal is found it can be reunited with you quickly.

Bush fire and total fire bans

The Rangers would like to remind all residential property owners or occupants that their properties must be compliant with the City's Fire Break Notice by 30 November 2022. Residential properties must be cleared of all inflammable material to a height no greater than 50mm. All other properties must create a firebreak around the property per the requirement of the notice available on the City's website.
