Local government elections were held across the state on Saturday 17 October.

In the City of Nedlands, only two positions were contested – both councillors from the Dalkeith Ward, Cr Ian Argyle and Cr Joe Porter. Both were returned as councillors.

All returning councillors will be sworn into office on Tuesday 27 October. The Deputy Mayor will also be elected then.
