Residents get involved in Local Planning Strategy

The City of Nedlands has been overwhelmed with the number responses for the Local Planning Strategy community consultation. People visited the City's engagement hub more than 1,400 times over the engagement period, which closed on 6 May after being open for six weeks.

The City also received 100 general enquiries relating to the Local Planning Strategy. Planners at the City held four open days over the six-week period, with 213 residents attending to find out more about the strategy.

People attending the open days and registering on the City's online engagement hub, Your Voice Nedlands, took up the opportunity to complete 420 surveys and submissions.

All this will be valuable feedback for planners as they collate and assess responses over the next few weeks. They will present a report to Council at its July meeting.

The next step is to send the report to Western Australian Planning Commission for adoption. The report will form the basis of the subsequent Local Planning Scheme.

We would like to thank everyone who came to an open day, completed a survey, made a submission or came in or called to ask a question.
