Our community nursery, on the banks of the Derbarl Yerrigan (Swan River), specialises in the propagation of native plants of Noongar Boodjar (the Swan Coastal Plain and Darling Scarp). Our team of nursery technicians, led by Nursery Manager Anna Kosiarski, is supported by committed volunteers working together to grow and care for our diverse array of native seedlings.

For 2026, we offer residents of our participating councils close to 200 species, some of which are endangered – a mix of ground covers, shrubs, trees, sedges and grasses.

**Forestry tubes cost \$6 each shared equally between the council and residents (\$3 council, \$3 resident).**

**Native Plant Subsidy Scheme is running exclusively May 1<sup>st</sup> – May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2026.**

Residents are welcome to purchase more than their individual council quota if they wish. For any extra purchases on the day, forestry tubes are sold at \$6/ea (inc. GST) for payment by card, merchant fees will apply.
