An extra fourth stamp will only be given for attending a bookable and facilitated activity or a Sunday Screening.





Catch a film these school holidays! Screenings of fun, family-friendly films will be held in the Nedlands Library, with snacks provided.

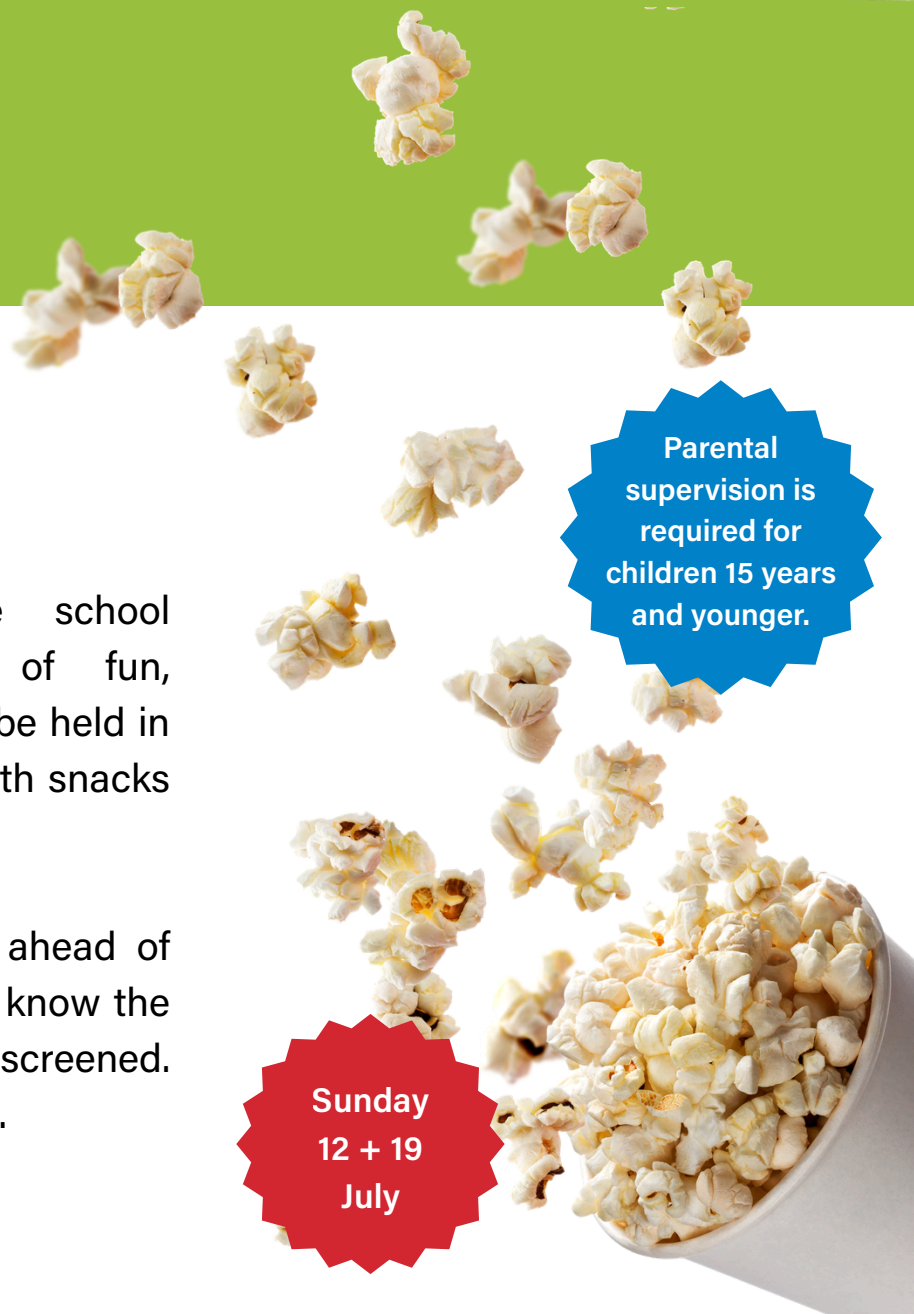
