Purpose

The purpose of this report is to award the contract for the supply and installation of sports lighting at Mt Claremont Oval for stage 2, being the final stage, of the sports lighting project at this location.

Recommendation to Committee

Council accepts the tender submitted by Hender Lee Electrical & Instrumentation Contractors Pty Ltd, for the supply and installation of sports lighting at Mt Claremont Oval in accordance with the submitted price of \$53,977.00 excluding GST.

Background

In 2010, Council instructed Administration to investigate options for the relocation of the UWA-Nedlands Football Club (UWANFC) from Paul Hasluck Reserve. This was in response to the Foreshore Enhancement Management Plan recommendations for converting Paul Hasluck Reserve to passive use. As part of this process, Mt Claremont Oval was identified as the preferred location to accommodate two full size soccer fields.

In the 2011/12 financial year Administration procured \$55,000 from the Regional and Local Community Infrastructure Program (RLCIP) to complete stage 1 of sports lighting provision at Mt Claremont Oval. UWANFC have been successful in securing Department of Sport and Recreation grant funding for completing stage 2 of the sports lighting project.

Council resolution

Council:

- receives the Nedlands Football Club's proposal for relocation away from Paul Hasluck Reserve;
- agrees to include an amount of \$286,220 in the 2010/11 draft budget for Council consideration, for infrastructure improvements to Mt Claremont Oval and Charles Court Reserve to facilitate the UWA-Nedlands Football Club's relocation; and
- directs administration to seek grant funding to help offset costs involved; and
- d) provides the UWA-Nedlands Football Club with permission to use Paul Hasluck Reserve for their 2011 season, pending completion of the lighting upgrades at Mt Claremont Oval and Charles Court Reserve.

Discussion

The tender was advertised in the West Australian newspaper on 4 August 2012 with tenders closing at 2pm on Tuesday 21 August 2012.

The tender was independently evaluated by two (2) officers from the Technical Services division and one (1) from the Corporate & Strategy division. Evaluations were conducted in accordance with the criteria specified in the tender documentation as set out in the below table:

After evaluation of the tender submissions, having attained an evaluation score of 95.17 it is recommended that Hender Lee Electrical & Instrumentation Contractors Pty Ltd be awarded the contract for the supply and installation of sports lighting at Mt Claremont Oval: Stage 2.
