Purpose

Administration is required to provide Council with a monthly financial report in accordance with *Regulation 34(1) of the Local Government (Financial Management) Regulations 1996.*

This report will ensure the City meets its statutory requirements.

Background

Regulation 34(1) of the Local Government (Financial Management) Regulations 1996 requires a local government to prepare a monthly statement of financial activity reporting on the revenue and expenditure, as set out in the annual budget.

A statement of financial activity and any accompanying documents are to be presented to the Council at the next ordinary meeting of the Council following the end of the month to which the statement relates, or to the next ordinary meeting of the council after that meeting. In addition to the above and in accordance with *Regulation 34(5)* of the *Local Government (Financial Management) Regulations 1996,* each year Council is required to adopt a percentage or value to be used in the reporting of material variances. For this financial year the amount is \$10,000 or 10% whichever is the greater.

Budget/Financial implications

As outlined in the Monthly Financial Report.

Risk Management

The monthly financial variance from the budget of each business unit is reviewed with the respective manager to identify the need for any remedial action. Significant variances are highlighted to Council in the Monthly Financial Report.

Discussion

This report covers the first month of the 20112/13 Financial Year. The City's Auditor has not completed the Audit of the 2011/12 Annual Financial Statements, and consequently the balances for the year have not been rolled over to the new financial year. Consequently, this report has only the Financial Summary for July by Business Units and the Summary of Capital Works and Acquisitions as its attachments.

The operating revenue for July was \$22.03 million, which is 81 % of the revenue Budget for 2012/13 adopted by Council on 16 June 2012. This reflects the fact that the Rates and bulk of the Sanitation charges for the whole year were levied in July.

The total operating expenses at the end of the reporting period was only \$1.52 million. This is 5% of the annual Budget, and is due to a number

of the invoices for expenses incurred in July not being received in that month, it being the first month of the financial year. Thus the expenses in this report are not truly representative of actual expenses incurred. This shortcoming will be minimised in future months.

The attached operating statement compares "Actual" with "Adopted Budget" by Business Units.

Variations from the adopted Budget of revenue and expenses by Directorates are highlighted in the following paragraphs.

Governance

Expenditure: Favourable variance of \$ 862 Revenue: Unfavourable variance of \$472

The variances are minimal.

Corporate & Strategy

Expenditure: Favourable variance of \$ 13,577 Revenue: Favourable variance of \$ 109,845

The small favourable expenditure variance is mainly due to no loan interest payments being made in July.

The favourable revenue variance is due mainly to the rates levied being marginally better than the profiled budget.

Community Services

Expenditure: Favourable variance of \$ 88,291 Revenue: Unfavourable revenue variance of \$ 3,684

The small favourable expenditure variance is due to invoices not being received for all expenses incurred in the month.

The unfavourable revenue variance is minimal.

Development Services

Expenditure: Favourable variance of \$ 112,953 Revenue: Favourable variance of \$ 37,270

The favourable expenditure variance is due to invoices not being received for all expenses incurred in the month.

The small favourable revenue variance is due mainly to better than budgeted revenue from Development Applications and Building Permits.

Technical Services

Expenditure: Favourable variance of \$ 1.13 million Revenue: Favourable variance of \$ 3.20 million

The large favourable expenditure variance is mainly due to not receiving in time the invoices for rubbish collection and tipping fees for the month of July. These will be picked up in August.

The large favourable revenue variance is due to the fact that the revenue for sanitation services was not profiled to reflect the fact that the bulk of the charges are levied in July. This will be rectified in the next report.

Capital Works Programme

Infrastructure projects require detailed operational planning and mobilisation once they have been approved by Council. As with previous years, very little construction work is done in the first two months of the financial year. Moreover, invoices for work done in July are invariably received only in August. Thus, at the end of July only \$139,393 of capital expenditure is shown in the report.

Conclusion

The financial statements for the first month indicate that operating expenses for the month were well below the pro-rata Budget. This is largely a timing issue due to the profiling of the Budget and the late receipt of invoices for purchase of services and products in July. This is to be expected in the first month of the financial year and is not a cause for concern.

The revenue is approximately 81 % of the Budget, and reflects that the Rates and Sanitation charges for the whole year were levied in July as planned.

With only four banks available to invest surplus funds, it is possible that on certain days the percentage of total investment with a bank may be marginally above the 30% limit. This will be rectified as soon as possible without "breaking" any of the Term Deposts.

Objective: To establish the criteria for considering requests for deputations to Council and Committees.

Context: The City of Nedlands Standing Orders Local Law provides for deputations to Council and Committee meetings, including Special Council and Committee meetings.

A deputation to Council may relate to any subject within the Council's jurisdiction. However, deputations to the Committee of the Whole Council and other Committees must only relate to items on the agenda of that Committee meeting.

Statement:

Any request for a deputation wishing to be received by the Council or a committee must be submitted in writing to the CEO who is to forward the request to the Mayor, or the Presiding Member of the Committee as the case may be.

The Mayor, or the Presiding Member of the Committee, may either approve the request, in which event the CEO is to invite the deputation to attend a meeting of the Council or committee as the case may be, or may instruct the CEO to refer the request to the Council or committee to decide by simple majority whether or not to receive the deputation.

A deputation invited to attend a Council or committee meeting –

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- is not to exceed 5 persons, only 2 of whom may address the Council or committee, although others may respond to specific questions from the members; and
- 2. is not to address the Council or committee for a period exceeding 15 minutes without the agreement of the Mayor, the Presiding Member, the Council or the committee as the case requires.

Any matter which is the subject of a deputation to the Council or a committee is not to be decided by the Council or that committee until the deputation has completed its presentation.

State Administrative Tribunal - Response To Appeals

Objective:	The policy outlines the approach to the Councils handling of matters in the State Administrative Tribunal.

Context: The State Administrative Tribunal (SAT) was established in Western Australia in 2005 as an independent body that makes and reviews a range of administrative decisions.

Decisions on planning applications made by the City are subject to the *State Administrative Tribunal Act 2004* and the *State Administrative Tribunal (Conferral of Jurisdiction) Amendment and Repeal Act 2004* (Conferral Act). Decision made by the City can be appealed.

Three (3) categories of decisions made by Council are dealt with differently by the City in regards to the SAT.

They are:

- Decisions made under delegation
- Decisions made by Council aligned with the Administration recommendation
- Decisions made by Council contrary to the Administration recommendation

Statement: These categories are handled by the City as follows:

Decisions made under delegation

Where a Council decision is made under delegation then an officer as nominated by the CEO shall act on behalf of the Council and make the decision as if it was made by the Council, and attend a mediation or tribunal hearing to represent Council's position.

Decisions made by Council aligned to the Administration recommendation

Where a Council decision is essentially the same as the Administration recommendation, then an officer as nominated by the CEO shall act on behalf of the Council and attend a mediation or tribunal hearing to represent Council's position.

Decisions made by Council contrary to the Administration recommendation

Where a decision of the Council is contrary to the recommendation of Administration then the Council may be represented by up to 2 elected members or by a Consultant. Administration will not be requested to represent the City.Where a decision of the Council is the subject of a right of review by the State Administrative Tribunal and that decision is contrary to the recommendation of Administration then the Chief Executive Officer shall arrange for Council to be represented in the following ways.

- The Mover and Seconder of the relevant motion shall be responsible for attending as a witness or in any other capacity necessary to a mediation or tribunal hearings and represent the Council's position. Where the Mover and/or Seconder are not available an alternative Elected Member may act in this capacity.
- Where no members of Council are prepared to represent the Council's position at the mediation or tribunal hearings then the Chief Executive Officer shall appoint a private consultant or advocate to act on the Council's behalf and attend any mediation or tribunal hearings as an expert witness.
- Council officers shall provide all necessary information to the nominated Member of the Council, consultant or advocate to assist in the compilation of a response or a witness statement.
- Council officers, if required, or subpoenaed can give evidence at a tribunal hearing in support of the officer's recommendation despite the fact that the evidence given may be contrary to the Council decision, and the subject of the appeal.

- Class 1 Applications In accordance with the *State Administrative Tribunal Act 2004*, the Council can receive legal representation only if the applicant chooses to elect that parties be represented by a lawyer.
- Class 2 Applications _ In accordance with the *State Administrative Tribunal Act 2004,* the Council may choose to be represented by a legal representative in place of, or in addition to, a private consultant or advocate.
- Upon receipt of an invitation from the SAT to reconsider the matter under s31 of the *State Administration Act 2004*, the officer and/or Council representative shall write a report for Council's reconsideration.

For all decisions, legal representation and/or relevant consultant/s may be used to handle SAT matters to support the officer or Council representatives, in accordance with the *State Administrative Act 2004 and Regulations*.

Where legal representation is so engaged, no elected member participating in a State Administrative Tribunal hearing shall act contrary to legal advise.

Where a Councillor is representing the Council's position at the State Administrative Tribunal they are not permitted to discuss the application with any person not directly involved in the SAT process.

Elected Members and employees involved in State Administrative Tribunal matters are reminded that they are to adhere to the City of Nedlands Code of Conduct, paying particular attention to clause 9.4:

9.4 Elected Members and employees are bound by Council and shall not engage in any communications or practices which are contrary to the effect of the Council decision.

Dinghy Storage on River Foreshore Reserves

KFA KFA 5 Governance

Status Council

- ResponsibleDivisionTechnical Services
- **Objective** The policy seeks to define Council's approach to the management of dinghy storage on river foreshore reserves under its care and control.

Context

Though it has been a common practice for some time, there is no established entitlement or protocol for the community to store private dinghies on public foreshore reserves which are under the care and control of the City.

The City's foreshore reserves sit within the Swan Canning Riverpark and are subject to the jurisdictional powers of the Swan River Trust as set out by the Swan and Canning Rivers Management Act 2006. The Swan River Trust introduced policy SRT/D26 - Dinghy Management along the Swan Canning Riverpark Shoreline in 2010. The policy requires the City to develop a management system to control dinghy storage on the Swan River foreshore if this is to remain a permissible practice.

For the purposes of this policy dinghy means a single hull watercraft no longer than 3.5m in length.

Statement

The City will develop and implement a management system for the storage of private dinghies on river foreshore reserves that:

- Complies with the requirements of the Swan River Trust's policies and, in doing so, allows the opportunity for the storage of dinghies, by its residents, on the river foreshore to continue;
- Allows only for licensed dinghies and/or tenders to larger vessels where they are used specifically for ship to shore transport and where its parent vessel's number is displayed on each side of the boat, forward of the transom;
- Gives consideration to the preservation of the Riverpark environment and to public amenity and access to foreshore reserves;
- Consults with the community regarding key decisions;

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- Is matched to the requirements of demand for dinghy storage on the foreshore to the extent possible;
- Promotes equitable access to storage facilities and is managed as a "user pays" facility;
- Requires owners to accept liability for loss or damage to dinghies stored on foreshore reserves; and
- Involves the scheduled auditing of foreshore reserves for compliance.

In addition, Section 5.44 of the Act allows the Chief Executive Officer to further delegate to any employee of the local government the exercise of any of the Chief Executive Officer's powers other than that of delegation.

Under Section 5.46 of the Act, a local government is required to review each financial year delegations that have been made. Council is also required to review annually the delegations it has made to the Chief Executive Officer.

At Council Meeting 22 May 2012, 13 Delegated Authorities were referred back to Administration for a Council Workshop. These 13 Delegated Authorities were workshopped on Tuesday 31 July 2012.

Changes made to Delegated Authorities are discussed below:

Amends the Delegated Authority – Private Works - by replacing the words "provided such works can be fitted into the works programme without undue disruption; such works may only be for properties within the City of Nedlands" with the words "provided that: such works can be fitted into the works programme without undue disruption; such works may only be for properties within the City of Nedlands, and; that the works are charged on a cost recovery basis, and that these fees are included in the City's schedule of fees and charges"

- Amends the Delegated Authority Traffic Management Committee

 by removing the word "Committee" from the title, and by replacing
 "Traffic Management Committee" with "Chief Executive Committee"
- Amends the Delegated Authority Use of Reserves during Building Operations on Adjacent Property - by adding the words "in consultation with the Mayor" after the words "Chief Executive Officer"
- Amends the Delegated Authority Town Planning Scheme No. 2 (TPS2) – Approval and Refusal of Planning Applications - by:
 - From 1a), deleting the word "where" from "where after advertising where no valid objections";
 - Replacing 1c) "Developments involving subdivision, producing up to four lots or amalgamations of up to four lots

and recommendations to the Western Australian Planning Committee of such subdivisions and amalgamations and that a copy of comments be made available to Elected Members as they are made available to the WAPC" with "Developments in accordance with the RCodes, involving subdivision or amalgamations, and any recommendations made to the Western Australian Planning Committee of such subdivisions and amalgamations, provided that a copy of comments be made available to Elected Members as they are made to the WAPC";

- In 1e), add the words "after advertising" after the words "comply with Council Policy";
- In 1h), replace "four (4) or less submissions" with "two (2) or less submissions"; and
- Further delegating to Planning Officers, 1b), 1e), 1f), 1g) (single storey developments only) and 1h) (single storey developments only).

In order to improve the time frames for processing Development Applications, it is proposed to include Planning Officers in the delegation to approve minor development applications. This will provide for the minor applications to be processed in a much timelier manner, avoiding the often lengthy delays of applications waiting for final signatures from 1-2 senior staff.

Providing for minor applications to be approved by a planning officer will improve flexibility (when senior officers are required to prioritise other requests, on leave etc) and will result in enhanced customer service, especially in regard to minor applications such as pools and patios. Officers will be able to move these minor applications through the system quickly, without the need to wait in line behind the large scale developments.

It will remain normal practice that the officer signing the final approval under delegation will be different to the officer processing the application. This means that an application is always checked by two people before it is approved.

The overall result will be increased resource and cost efficiencies within the planning team and enhanced customer service to the ratepayers.

4. Amends the Delegated Authority – Trading in Public Places - by adding "("charitable organisation" as defined by the City of Nedlands Local Law Relating to Trading in Public Places" after the words "charitable organisation"

- 5. Amends the following Delegated Authorities by adding the words "in consultation with the Mayor" after the word "Fund"
 - Community Grants; and
 - Sponsorship of Youth Initiatives Fund

In addition to these changes, Council requested clarification of items contained within a number of Delegated Authorities which are below:

- 1. Town Planning Scheme No. 2 (TPS2) Approval and Refusal of Planning Applications
 - Council requested confirmation that section 4.a and 4.b does not delegate authority to Administration to set, approve or reject operating hours for a premise with a Liquor License or Gaming License.
 - Sections 4.a and 4.b do not delegate authority to Administration to set, approve or reject operating hours. Section 40. Certificates only provide confirmation to the Liquor Licensing Authority that the Applicant has already complied with the Town Planning Scheme and already has the relevant development approvals in place.
- 2. Trading in Public Places
 - Council requested the following: inclusion of a definition of "charitable organisation" and; substitution of "charitable organisation" with "not-for-profit organisation".
 - The definition of "charitable organisation" is as it appears in the City of Nedlands Local Law Relating to Trading in Public Places, and is copied below:
 - "charitable organisation" means a charitable, benevolent, religious, recreational or other voluntary institution, association, society or body, whether incorporated or not, whose members are not entitled nor permitted to receive any pecuniary profit from the transactions;
 - A substitution of "charitable organisation" for "not-for-profit organisation" is not possible, as this would be inconsistent with the City of Nedlands Local Law Relating to Trading in Public Places.
- 3. Active Recreation Area Use
 - Council requested clarification regarding what this Delegation of Authority refers to. This refers to the City of Nedlands Administration Protocol Recreation: Physical. A copy of this Protocol is attached for your reference.

- 4. Retaining the following Delegations of Authority, unchanged, are recommended:
 - Requests for Financial Assistance
 - Landscaping River Foreshores
 - Issuing Section 3.25 Notices
 - Signing of Metropolitan Region Scheme Form 1 Applications
 - Liquor Licensing Act Functions
 - Active Recreation Area Use

Administration recommends the removal of the numbering of Delegations, as the numbers do not link to the relevant Council Policies, as numbering of Council Policies has already previously been revoked.

Conclusion

A review of Delegation is required to be undertaken each financial year. At the Council Meeting 22 May 2012, a number of Delegated Authorities were referred back to Administration to be workshopped with Council. This workshop was held on Tuesday 31st July 2012, and these Delegations of Authority are now being re-presented to Council for adoption.

Objective	To provide guidance on the provision of sport and non-structured recreational services provided by the City.

Context

The City ensures community access to a wide range of physical recreational opportunities. These include participation in structured sporting clubs and unstructured recreation (e.g. walking, cycling).

Statement

The City's main role in relation to physical recreation is to ensure access to facilities.

These facilities may include:

- Reserves and ovals
- Pavilions and clubrooms
- Footpaths and cycle ways
- Aquatic facilities.

Exclusive use:

Where a sporting club requires exclusive use of a facility (e.g. a bowling club) the City may grant exclusive use through a standard lease.

The key features of the lease will be:

- No rent to be paid by the Club
- All building maintenance and utilities costs to be paid by the Club.

The underlying principle of the standard lease is "at no cost to Council".

Non exclusive use:

Where a sporting club requires non-exclusive use of a facility (e.g. seasonal club) the City may grant one-off or regular hire through the City's bookings system. A hire fee will apply. Facilities available for hire are maintained by the City.



Facility Development:

Sporting Clubs may apply to Council for grant assistance towards their facility development. Council may endorse the club's facility development without providing a financial contribution towards it. Applications for facility funding will be considered against the following criteria:

- Impact on physical activity levels
- Priority rating in the Strategic Recreation Plan
- Multi-use
- Community impact

Applications from sporting clubs for facility funding will be considered only as part of the Department of Sport and Recreation's CSRFF (Community Sport and Recreation Facilities Fund) funding rounds.
