1.1 Ms R Potter - 80 Monash Avenue, Nedlands - Noise from delivery trucks using a delivery entrance on Monash Avenue, Nedlands

The Presiding Member, on behalf of Ms R M Potter of 80 Monash Avenue, Nedlands will table the following question received on 31 May 2011 in relation to noise from delivery trucks using a delivery entrance on Monash Avenue, Nedlands.

Question

I wish to know the outcome of the datae provided by me [completed noise investigation request forms] regarding the 'traffic' [out of hours' deliveries to Hollywood Private Hospital, Hollywood Medical Suites, Regis Health Care and Queen Elizabeth II Medical Centre] and how Council envisages it will address and solve the issues.

Answer

The complaint forms log incidences of noise from delivery trucks to Regis Health Care, Hollywood Private Hospital, Hollywood Medical Suites, Regis Health Care and the Queen Elizabeth II (QEII) Medical Centre on Monash Avenue, Nedlands.

Noise from the propulsion and braking systems of motor vehicles operating on roads is exempt under the Environmental Protection (Noise) Regulations 1997 (the Regulations) and motor vehicles servicing premises are not restricted to particular times of day, unless conditioned in a development approval. Where noise from service/delivery vehicles (not operating on roads) is allegedly unreasonable, this noise can be compared with the assigned (allowable) noise levels stipulated in the Regulations.

The City has raised the issue of service vehicles with both Regis Health Care and Hollywood Private Hospital who both engage on an ongoing basis with their suppliers. It has been acknowledged by the organisations that they are constrained at times by the delivery companies requirements.

In regard to service vehicles using roads within the noise regulations, the City can only take a liaison role with these organisations to raise community issues/concerns and try and get a better outcome.

In regards to noise relating to construction vehicles for the QEII Central Plant, there is a traffic management plan for construction on the site and the City is working with QEII to ensure ongoing compliance with this.

"As business operators in the area we the undersigned advise that we strongly object to the proposed changes to Broadway Nedlands road, (East and West side) between corner of Stirling Highway, South to corner of Cooper street, as detailed in figures 36-37, (existing and modified intersection) on page 17, of the booklet entitled "Hampden Broadway North Hollywood Concept Information – Community Engagement".

We therefore request that you postpone any change whatsoever to the abovementioned road without further consultation with the attached concerned signatories."

Recommendation to Council

Committee Recommendation / Amended Recommendation to Committee

Council approves an application for Retrospective Amendments to a previously approved Two Storey Dwelling at No. 9 (Lot 54) Iris Avenue, Dalkeith in accordance with the application dated 15 February 2011 and the amended plans dated 2 March 2011 subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The north facing windows from the ground floor study, home theatre and lounge/living room are to be screened or obscure glazed to a minimum height of 1.65m above natural ground level in accordance with the Residential Design Codes.
- 2. All storm water from building and paving areas (including driveways) shall be contained on site by draining to soakwells of adequate capacity to contain runoff from a 10 year recurrent storm event and the capacity of soakwells shall be a minimum of one (1) cubic metre for every 80 m² of paved or roofed surface on the property.
- 3. The retaining walls and boundary fencing and footings shall be constructed wholly inside the allotment.
- 4. The use of bare or painted metal building materials is permitted on the basis that, if during or following the erection of the development the Council forms the opinion

that glare which is produced from the building has or will have a significant detrimental effect upon the amenity of neighbouring properties, the Council may require the owner to treat the building/roof to reduce the reflectivity to a level acceptable to Council.

- 5. A grated channel strip-drain shall be constructed across the driveway, aligned with and wholly contained within the property boundary and the discharge from this drain to be run to a soakwell situated within the property.
- 6. Any swimming pool soak well shall not be situated closer than 1.8 m to any boundary of a lot, building, septic tank or other soak well.
- 7. Any additional development, which is not in accordance with the original application or conditions of approval, as outlined above, will require further approval by Council.

Advice Notes specific to this approval:

- 1. All internal WC's and ensuites without window access to outside air must be serviced by mechanical ventilation, which is ducted to outside air and the minimum rate of air change must be equal or greater than 25 litres per second.
- 2. Property owners are required by law to ensure that mechanical devices located on their property such as air conditioners do not create unreasonable noise to neighbouring properties. It is strongly advised that consultation be undertaken with the air conditioner installer and adjoining neighbour(s) prior to installation of any airconditioner equipment.
- 3. In the event of a noise complaint being received by the City, remedial action (including potential relocation or other attenuation measures) may be required or the air conditioner may be prohibited from being used. It is recommended that applicants refer to the City's Visual and Acoustic Privacy Information document and also the online fairair noise calculator online at. Further advice can be sought from Acoustic Engineers who are listed in the Yellow Pages under "Acoustical Consultants".
- 4. Prior to the commencement of works, any consents or approvals required under the *Strata Titles Act 1985* will need to be obtained.

- 1. The overheight portion of the boundary fence located in the 9m primary street setback area is to be reduced to a maximum height of 1.8 m above natural ground level as marked on the plans and in accordance with the Residential Design Codes (RCodes) requirements visually permeable.
- 2. The north facing windows from the ground floor lounge and home theatre are to be screened or obscure glazed to a minimum height of 1.65 m above natural ground level in accordance with the RCodes.
- 3. All storm water from building and paving areas (including driveways) shall be contained on site by draining to soakwells of adequate capacity to contain runoff from a 10 year recurrent storm event and the capacity of soakwells shall be a minimum of one (1) cubic metre for every 80 m² of paved or roofed surface on the property.
- 4. The retaining walls and boundary fencing and footings shall be constructed wholly inside the allotment.
- 5. The use of bare or painted metal building materials is permitted on the basis that, if during or following the erection of the development the Council forms the opinion that glare which is produced from the building has or will have a significant detrimental effect upon the amenity of neighbouring properties, the Council may require the owner to treat the building/roof to reduce the reflectivity to a level acceptable to Council.
- 6. A grated channel strip-drain shall be constructed across the driveway, aligned with and wholly contained within the property boundary and the discharge from this drain to be run to a soakwell situated within the property.
- 7. Any swimming pool soak well shall not be situated closer than 1.8 m to any boundary of a lot, building, septic tank or other soak well.

14.1 Councillor Tan – Exercise equipment in our playgrounds

In accordance with Standing Orders, Councillor Tan gave notice of her intention to move the following at this meeting.

Council directs Administration to:

- 1. investigate opportunities to integrate/install exercise equipment for all ages in and around our playgrounds so as to facilitate intergenerational interaction and encourage a healthier lifestyle within the community; and
- 2. investigate funding opportunities for the above at a broader level other than Government grants, eg through corporate sponsorship and donations from various stakeholders and Community groups in the City.

Supporting Comments from Councillor Tan

This notice of motion envisages several positive outcomes:

- 1. the installation of exercise equipment in close proximity to playground areas as opposed to the current practice of scattered installation around the City;
- 2. the encouragement of informal physical activities in the Community (including family groups) to promote a healthier lifestyle;
- 3. opportunities for wider Community interaction;
- sourcing wider alternative funding other than Govt grants, for example Rotary Clubs in the area, and developers (as per TPS3); and
- 5. involving the various groups and stakeholders in the City in actual Community Building and Bonding as per Vision 2030.

Administration Comment

Administration supports the location of exercise equipment in proximity to playgrounds to provide opportunity for increasing community interaction, particularly across different age-groups. Providing exercise equipment provides opportunity for physical activity for a diverse range of community members. Locating the exercise equipment near playgrounds provides opportunity for physical activity plus interaction between users of the playground (grandparents, parents, children) and

users of the exercise equipment (all age groups). Physical activity and local interaction both contribute to community well-being.

The City maintains relationships with various local service organisations including Rotary and can work with Administrative staff and local service organisations on funding for such projects, as well as through our grants processes.

14.2 Councillor Hipkins – Broadway Clearways

In accordance with Standing Orders, Councillor Hipkins gave notice of his intention to move the following at this meeting.

That the decision to implement "Clearway" car parking bans in Broadway between Cooper Street and Stirling Highway be deferred for six months to allow discussions with affected adjoining owners and an explanation for the proposed works.

Supporting Comments from Councillor Hipkins

Clearways in Broadway at the Stirling Highway intersection were approved under delegation by Traffic Management Committee, item 7.5 on 17 May 2011.

Subsequent representations from building owners and operators adversely affected by the decision indicate that they have not been consulted or informed as to the reasons for the decision or what options are available.

There is no urgency to undertake the work. A delay to allow affected parties to be better informed and examine options would be beneficial to the City's community relations.

Administration Comment

As outlined in the Notice of Motion Traffic Management Committee have approved a 6 month trial for a clearway during the morning and afternoon peak times on Broadway at the Stirling Highway as follows:

b) notes the change to the existing 5 minute parking bays to incorporate Clearways (Monday to Friday, 7.30 am to 9 am and 4.15 pm to 6 pm) on Broadway between Cooper Street and Stirling Highway for a 6 month trial period.

This action has been auctioned by Administration and is currently being implemented. Letters advising of the trial were sent to surrounding shops and residents on 20 May 2011. Instillation of the signage is currently programmed to be undertaken in 3 weeks.

This Signage will be installed for a six month trial period to indicate changes to parking restrictions between Stirling Highway and Cooper Street on Broadway.

The city's car park behind the shopping area offers more than 20 car bays and may be accessed via Cooper Street with safe, pedestrian access through to Broadway. Other issues raised by the business owners are currently being investigated.

14.3 Councillor Hipkins – Loftus and Napier Streets drainage works

In accordance with Standing Orders, Councillor Hipkins gave notice of his intention to move the following at this meeting.

That work on the Loftus and Napier Street drainage works be undertaken as a matter of urgency and, following detained design, if further funding for additional work is required an immediate request is to be submitted to Council for an ex budget allocation to complete the work at the earliest possible date.

Supporting Comments from Councillor Hipkins

Serious flooding in Loftus Street occurred in March last year and again in May this year. As the wet season has already arrived, the planned work must be undertaken urgently to avoid future flooding.

Loftus and Napier Street sumps have to be upgraded at approximately \$50,000 each and \$100,000 has been included in the 20011/20012 budget to undertake the work. On budget approval a detailed plan will be prepared by a drainage consultant that includes small retaining walls, excavation, re-contouring, turf, trees, etc, with works commencing as soon as possible. The work does not include the overflow piping in/through private property. This will have to be reviewed in the detailed design. If extra work and funding is required, it is important that this not be delayed.

The CEO is talking to Claremont about the work it will have to undertake to fully solve the drainage problem in the area.

Administration Comment

Administration has proposed \$100,000 be included in the 20011/20012 budget to undertake the drainage works in both Lotus and Napier street sumps. Once approved, it is anticipated the work will be undertaken in July 2011 as a matter of urgency.

Administration also proposes to prepare a detailed design of the overflow piping, which runs through private property. A subsequent report will be presented to Council if additional funds are required to complete the works.

3. Procedural Matters

Her Worship the Mayor outlined the procedures of the meeting.

Meeting procedures

- 1. Electors only may speak except with approval of the person presiding.
- 2. Only an elector may vote.
- 3. An elector does not have to vote.
- 4. When addressing the meeting, a person is to
 - rise and remain standing unless unable to do so by reason of sickness or disability;
 - b) state his or her name for recording in the minutes;
 - c) address the meeting through the person presiding.
- 5. No motion or amendment is open to debate until it has been seconded. Only one amendment on any one motion shall be received at a time and such amendment shall be disposed of before any further amendment can be received; but any number of amendments may be proposed.
- 6. The mover of a motion (but not the mover of an amendment) has the right of reply, and this closes the debate.
- 7. An elector may rise and move without discussion, "that the question be now put", which, on being duly seconded and carried by a majority, will result in submission of the motion at once to the meeting, after the mover has replied.
- 8. Each elector has one vote.
- 9. Voting is determined by show of hands or other form of open voting determined by the person presiding.
- 10. A simple majority carries the vote.
- 11. The person presiding is to determine questions of order and procedure not stated above but an elector may move a motion of dissent from a ruling of the person presiding, which if seconded, shall be put without discussion.
- 12. Minutes of this meeting will be available for inspection by members of the public as from Monday 30 May 2011 and will be considered by the Council at its meeting to be held on Tuesday 28 June 2011.
- 13. The decisions of this meeting are not binding on the Council, but as required by the Local Government Act, the reasons for any Council decision on a decision of this meeting are to be recorded in the minutes of the council meeting.

Definition of Elector

An elector is defined in the Local Government Act 1995. An elector is a person who is eligible to vote in an election of the City of Nedlands.


