6. Proposed amalgamation between the City of Nedlands and the City of Subiaco

On 3 June 2011 Mr G Foster, Chief Executive Officer received a request from Councillors Hipkins, Argyle, Tyson and Collins, in accordance with section 5.4 of the *Local Government Act 1995* calling for a special meeting of Council for the purpose of discussing the proposed amalgamation between the City of Nedlands and the City of Subiaco.

Moved – Councillor Hipkins Seconded – Councillor Collins

That Council:

- 1. prior to voting on whether to proceed with the proposed amalgamation with the City of Subiaco, the City of Nedlands carries out a survey of all electors to determine their views on the amalgamation; and
- 2. if motion 1. is decided in the affirmative, the Electoral Commission be asked to undertake a postal ballot of the electors of the City of Nedlands with the following question:

Are you in favour of the City of Nedlands amalgamating with the City of Subiaco? $\hfill\square$ Yes $\hfill\square$ No

That Standing Order No. 9.5 be suspended for the purpose of allowing Councillors to address the meeting more than once.
