8. Items for Discussion

8.1 Waterwise Garden Competition

Mr A Melville advised the meeting that the Waterwise Garden Competition closed with a total of 18 entries on 31 August 2015. Simon Pawley of Sustainable Outdoors, Native Landscaping & Landcare Services, recently completed judging of the entries. Prizes are to be awarded to the winners at the Ordinary Meeting of Council on 27 October 2015.

The committee questioned if there was a plaque to present with the certificate for the competition winner.

8.2 Switch your thinking

The Mayor outlined the 'Switch Your Thinking' program which is a local government initiative that inspires sustainable action in the community of Perth, Western Australia.

To achieve their objective of reducing local greenhouse gas emissions, they partner with Perth Councils, local businesses and community groups, to help the people of Perth to live and work in a way that meets their needs without jeopardising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs.

The Mayor suggested that the City of Nedlands join. The Mayor has requested that the City investigate what is involved with joining this initiative such as cost, and the program's Terms of Reference.

8.3 Sustainable Nedlands Newsletter

Ms G Stubber requested that the Committee enter discussion and give consideration to the production of a community newsletter.

It was suggested that the City develop a newsletter detailing not only what the City is doing but what is happening around the City in an easy to read format.

The committee is interested in developing an electronic format that is not clumsy to use, without the need to know the date the event is on to find it.

The Committee request a discussion from Administration with the IT or Communications manager to discuss ideas to improve the distribution of community information.

8.4 Commencement Time

Ms B Tyson requested that the Committee enter discussion and give consideration to schedule future meetings to start at an earlier time of 5pm.

With minimal discussion the matter has been deferred until the first agenda of the new committee following Council elections.

8.5 Sustainable Street Lighting

Ms B Channon requested an update on the status of the sustainable street lighting actions (see attached outstanding actions) from the Committee.


This is the final meeting for this term of the Sustainable Nedlands Committee. Following Council's appointment of the new Committee, dates will be advertised.



There being no further business, the Presiding Member declared the meeting closed at 6.54pm.




