First stage of shared pathway complete

The opening of Stage 1 of the shared pathway along Brockway Road from Underwood Avenue to Lemnos Street was celebrated this week. Further stages will see the shared pathway continue along Brockway Road to Quintillian Avenue linking to cycle paths alongside Stubbs Terrace.

A joint project with the WA Department of Transport (DoT), the pathway provides a safe travel alternative for students and others riding to work or for leisure.
