I'm pleased to announce the City of Nedlands is now a participating member of the Western Metropolitan Regional Council (WMRC).

This membership will help us streamline our waste management and allow residents to use WMRC's recycle centre in Shenton Park free of charge.

The move to join WMRC follows our great success with the rollout of FOGO bins. which has diverted hundreds of tonnes of Nedlands household waste from landfill since it was introduced in November.

Waste management is another area of sustainability the City of Nedlands can lead on.

I am also pleased to announce the 1000 tree seedlings I pledged to gift the City in February, have all now been bought. Our new green friends, will be welcomed to the City of Nedlands and most likely reside at the depot before they are planted at a nature strip near you.

These trees are in addition to the 500 street trees currently being planted as part of our annual tree planting program.

The City of Nedlands is leading the Perth metropolitan area in the protection and expansion of the urban tree canopy and I sincerely thank the community for their energy and passion in this space. Together we can, and will, make a lasting impact for future generations to enjoy.

Capital works:

Smyth Road

Rehabilitation works continue on Smyth Road, from Aberdare Road to Carrington Street.

This rehabilitation is expected to be completed in mid-June, with contractors conducting works between 7am - 5pm on weekdays.

The City will attempt to provide residents with local access and alternative routes for motorists in the event of partial road closures.

Rochdale Road

Rehabilitation works are expected to begin on Rochdale Road this month.

DM Roads has been contracted to conduct the works, from Alfred Road to Haldane Street between 7am 5pm on weekdays.

The City is asking residents and road users to prepare for traffic disruptions during these times.
