You may hand deliver your postal voting papers to an electoral officer, or **obtain a replacement package** (if the package is not received, or should any papers be missing), **on election day** at the following locations and times:

Chief Polling Place:

Mt Claremont Community Centre - Banksia Room, 105 Montgomery Avenue, MOUNT CLAREMONT **8am - 6pm**

Other Polling Place:

City of Nedlands Administration Centre, 71 Stirling Highway, NEDLANDS **8am - 4pm**

The count of votes will commence after 6pm at the Mt Claremont Community Centre - Banksia Room, 105 Montgomery Avenue, MOUNT CLAREMONT.
