Mayor's Message

January and February have been busier than usual for Nedlands Council. We have critical work to do in establishing our local planning and policy framework which will encourage responsible development. At January's Special Council meeting a draft Local Planning Policy for Broadway was passed and has been advertised. More policies are in the pipeline.



Work to address gaps in our Local Planning Strategy is also progressing with a Mayoral-led working group for the Perth-Fremantle rail line redevelopment commencing in April and including the Federal Member for Curtin.

We're also pleased with the success of the policy trial for the West Hollywood Underground Power project which led to the Energy Minister's recent announcement that this funding model will continue. The City is proud of the influence we've had on State government policy, to achieve this cost-effective approach to underground power and greatly increase our chances of rolling it out across our City in a timely and efficient way.
