These lamps are made from pressed jute paper and the inside of the lantern spins on a motorised base to cast shadows on the paper shade. After studying some past and contemporary shadow puppetry, create your own silhouette design for your own lamp.

- Due to popularity of courses, places cannot be held without payment.
- An enrolled student cannot have another individual attend a class in their absence.
- Students may only attend the day and time of the class they are enrolled in.
- Swapping of classes is not permitted.
- Participants in the term courses, full day and weekend workshops must be over 18 years of age.
- No children are to accompany an adult to classes.
- Courses without the minimum number of participants by one week before the start date of the course will be cancelled.
- Most courses require additional materials to be purchased by the student.
- A 20% administration fee applies to cancellations made prior to the beginning of term.
- No refund will be given once term has commenced.
- Classes are not held on public holidays.
- Course start and finishing dates may vary due to public holidays and availability of the course tutor.
- A full refund will only be given if a course is cancelled by the Tresillian Arts Centre.
- A refund will only be given if you have a medical certificate for the dates you have missed.
