City of Nedlands and the Town of Cambridge awarded a grant to improve road safety

The City of Nedlands and the Town of Cambridge have been awarded a Road Rehabilitation Grant for \$580,000 from the Metropolitan Regional Road Group to upgrade the intersection of Brockway Road, Brookdale Street and Underwood Avenue.

The proposed design is intended to increase safety, reduce congestion, and reduce the overall number of and severity of crashes. Pedestrian and cyclist facilities will also be improved along with improving visibility from an upgrade to the street lighting and LED technology upgrade of the traffic signals.

The City of Nedlands Mayor Max Hipkins said he welcomed the recent news from Main Roads (MRWA) that the grant for the joint project had been successful.

“The City is very pleased to receive the funding for this important local infrastructure project.”

“Both the Town of Cambridge and the City of Nedlands are pleased that the safety issues at this intersection have been recognised by Main Roads WA and the funding for the upgrade to the intersection goes a long way to help enhance and improve road safety within the City.”

The Town of Cambridge Mayor Keri Shannon said Cambridge Council was pleased to support the City of Nedlands’ road improvement works.

“The Town fully supported the City of Nedlands to have this intersection upgraded and we are delighted the funding application was successful.
