### **Local school regenerates 1,000 plants on Schools Tree Day**

The foreshore at Point Resolution Reserve on Victoria Avenue in Dalkeith received a rejuvenation boost from local Primary School students on Schools Tree Day last Friday.

Thirty children aged between 9-10 years old from Nedlands Primary School, planted 1,000 native seedlings along the river foreshore.

The City of Nedlands Mayor Max Hipkins said: 'The partnership between the City and the local schools is strong and integral for assisting the City in rejuvenating local bushland.'

'Each year local schools assist the City's Environmental Conservation team to plant native seedlings at different areas across the City. The exercise teaches children about the importance of protecting and regenerating our natural bushland.'
