Their set list will highlight the vocal talents of the trio as well as providing a welcome spin on popular classics. You've never heard The Cure or The Human League quite like this!

"Following the success of the first summer concert last week, we anticipate the Wesleys will also draw a large crowd this Sunday," said City of Nedlands Mayor Max Hipkins.

The band started 10 years ago when it was originally a side project for members of the popular band "Murphy's Lore". Since then the Wesleys have made a name for themselves in popular Perth venues including Eurobar, Rosie O'Grady's, The Balmoral, The Como and The Vic as well as special events and weddings.

The concert is a sustainable and environmentally friendly event. As part of the City's commitment to reduce, reuse and recycle, the City is aiming to make the concerts as litter free and as sustainable as possible.
