## **Thoughts wanted on potential hockey home**

Do you want to have a say on the Westside Wolves Hockey Club proposal to build permanent hockey facilities at Mt Claremont Oval?

The City of Nedlands wishes to understand the level of community support for the project and is inviting people to provide feedback.

“This consultation will assist with the decision-making process on whether to approve a period for the hockey club to further investigate and develop a detailed proposal and business plan,” Nedlands Mayor Max Hipkins said.

“There are currently 12 artificial pitches in the Perth metropolitan area and three of these are in the western suburbs.

“For this proposal to proceed, any future arrangements need to be negotiated with the existing clubs and organisations that currently use the oval including the Western Suburbs and Swanbourne Cricket Clubs, Claremont-Nedlands Cricket Club, UWA Nedlands Football Club, Claremont Jets and Mt Claremont Primary School.

“The balance of the area still needs to be available for other sporting groups and community activities including passive recreation.

“Ultimately, we want to know if this is the right thing for the community – and the best way to find out is to actually ask the community.”
