Storm creates havoc in Nedlands

The latest Autumn storm to hit the metropolitan area has seriously damaged the much-loved artwork “Asteroid” located at the intersection of Broadway and The Avenue, Nedlands.

City of Nedlands Parks Service workers discovered the damage early this morning, made the site safe and returned the damaged section to the City of Nedlands depot. Repair work will commence as soon as practicable.

A light pole at the tennis courts at College Park was also blown over in the storm. This site has been secured, the area made safe and the pole removed for repairs.

The courts have been reopened and the light will be replaced as soon as possible.
