Alfred Road night works scheduled to reduce road disruptions

A new Roads 2000 program of road upgrades including road surfacing and kerb repairs will be carried out in Alfred Road, Swanbourne commencing Monday 8 June, 2020.

The works will take approximately two weeks, depending on weather conditions.

During the first week, 8 to 12 June, works will be carried out during the day with lane closures in place.

The second week, 15-19 June will be nightworks carried out between 7.00pm and 6.00am. Road closures will be in place during the nightworks with detours around the work site.

Noise restriction measures and traffic management will be activated throughout the project. Residents and visitors to the area should plan for some travel delays.

All contractors have been instructed to adhere to appropriate COVID-19 restrictions including social distancing.
