## **Riverbank Grants Scheme 2015 -16 Point Resolution Reserve**

The City of Nedlands in collaboration with the Department of Parks and Wildlife have commenced a river foreshore restoration project at Point Resolution Reserve. This project is being undertaken with funding received through the Department of Parks and Wildlife's Riverbank Grants program and will involve undertaking a 12 month foreshore monitoring project, stabilising eroded areas, undertaking invasive weed control and revegetating degraded foreshore areas with approximately 3000 local provenance species. This project aims to increase biodiversity and improve habitat along the Swan River foreshore as well as helping to protect the river reserve from exposure to high energy waves and natural erosion processes.
