Young Artists Emerge!

A record 114 young artists have entered the City of Nedlands Emerge Youth Art Awards 2014. Emerge: Youth Art Awards is an exhibition and awards ceremony for artists aged 12–25 years in Western Australia. A prize pool of \$2,000 will be awarded on Saturday 23 August, 2-6pm at John Leckie Pavilion, Nedlands.

Young people throughout the Western Suburbs and beyond have entered with a range of two dimensional artworks including print, photography, painting, drawing etc. Last year the City of Nedlands held the inaugural event, and this year is set to build on the success of last year.

The works will be on display on Saturday 23 August at John Leckie Pavilion. This event is free to the public and will include live music performances by Kyle Bonser Band, Sam Wylde and Julia Nicholls. Voting for the People's Choice Award will take place at the exhibition, with an awards ceremony for all categories.
